Mia is watching her big brother Theo on the toilet: and she wants that too! So, her Mum gives her a colourful toilet attachment. First it doesn't work, but then Mia pees in the toilet! And later the big business also ends up there. Finally, Mia sleeps her first night without a nappy! A mix of narrative and informative texts and cheerful illustrations tell children all about taking a bath, washing their hair, brushing their teeth and going to the toilet.



## 7 I like Ponys!\*

Amelie is very excited! Together with her friend and her older sister she is visiting a pony farm and is going riding for the first time. But before, they take a look around the farm. On their tour, they pet, feed and groom the horses and watch the other children take a riding lesson. How well the others can already do that! And then they finally get to ride! Lovely illustrations and an exciting story teach the handling of animals in a playful way!



## 8 There's a lot going on at the Zoo!\*

What an adventure! The two kindergarten children Lina and Tom are out and about at the zoo with animal keeper Uli. There they meet a cheeky giraffe that nibbles on Lina's hat, are allowed to visit the new born tapir baby and get a taste of the elephant shower. From monkeys to zebras, the two take a close look at all the animals in the zoo, watch them bath, play and eat, take a look in the feeding kitchen and have their food snatched from their hands in the petting zoo.

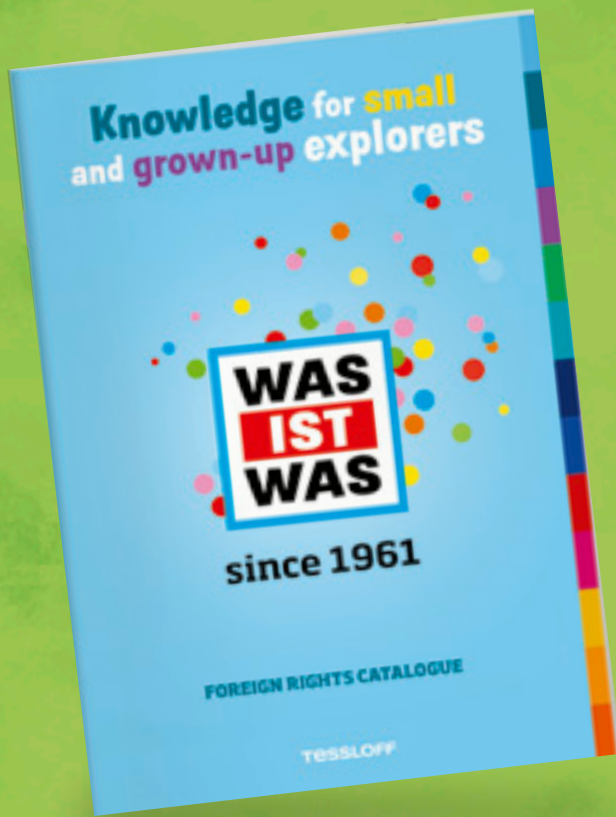
